**HORTICULTURE DIVISION GENERAL RULES**

1. This show is organized, staged and judged in accordance with the rules of the American Rose Society as set forth in the *Guidelines and Rules for Judging Roses*.
2. All exhibitors must be registered for the 2008 NCNH District Conference. Exhibitors placing entries in Section D must reside in the NCNH District of the American Rose Society.
3. The preparation area will be open at 4:30 a.m., Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. Entries will be accepted until 9:30 a.m. Judging will start at 10:00 a.m. and should be finished by approximately 1:00 p.m.
4. Only one exhibitor or team from one garden may enter any one class.
5. All roses must have been grown outdoors in the exhibitor's garden.
6. All roses must be correctly named and exhibited under their approved ARS Exhibition Name. The variety must be listed in an ARS recognized publication.
7. Judges who are judging this show may place entries ONLY in the Judges' sections, "J" in the Horticulture division and Section "M" of the Arrangements division. Please advise the Arrangement Chairman if you will exhibit arrangements.
8. This is an alphabetical show. An exhibitor may enter as many roses in Section A as desired, as long as each entry is a different variety. Entries in Section A will be placed alphabetically by their name, and each variety will constitute a sub-class. Climbing roses other than those eligible for Class 8 must be entered in the same classes as the bush varieties of that type.
9. All entries must be made according to the schedule or be disqualified. Entry tags must be completed correctly: top and bottom portion must show Section, Class, Variety, and Exhibitor's Name and Address. The bottom portion must be folded so that the exhibitor's name will not be visible during judging. Entry tags will be provided.
10. Wedges are allowed, but must stay below the top of the container. Entries should be cleaned of insects, fungus, and any spray residue. No foreign substance is allowed.
11. Placement assistants will be available to guide exhibitors in placing their entries.
12. In both the alphabetical and challenge classes, multiple first, second, and third place ribbons can be awarded as long as they are awarded to different varieties.
13. Only first place winners are eligible for trophies and awards. Judges must write "Trophy" or "Certificate" on all class winner tags.
14. Exhibits must remain intact until after the Banquet dinner Saturday night.
15. General Horticulture Rose Show awards will be presented at 4:30 p.m. Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. NCNH District awards will be presented at the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening October 4<sup>th</sup>. All winners should be present or make arrangements for the acceptance of their awards.
16. On Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, personal property must be removed from the prep area as soon after 10 a.m. as is possible.
17. The Humboldt or Shasta Rose Societies will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit or personal property of exhibitors.
18. The decision of the judges is final.

## GROOMING INFORMATION

1. Read and follow the Show Schedule carefully.
2. Complete all entry tags clearly. Top and bottom must show Section, Class, Variety, and Exhibitor's Name and Address.
3. A winning "Show Rose" should be one-half to three-quarters open at judging time.
4. Stem length should be proportional to the size of the bloom.
5. Clean blossom and foliage; remove any debris, insects, fungi, and/or spray residue.
6. All Hybrid Teas (including Climbing Hybrid Teas) must be shown disbudded. Single Hybrid Teas (4-8 petals are shown naturally grown, not disbudded).
7. A spray must have at least two blooms and, ideally, should have more.

## POINT SCORE FOR JUDGING SPECIMENS

**Form:** **25 points**  
Elegance, dignity, true to expected form, with well-formed center and symmetrically arranged petals

**Color:** **20 points**  
Typical of the variety, Shall include freshness, brilliance and purity

**Substance:** **15 points**  
Quality and quantity of matter in the petals. Substance comprises the texture, crispness, firmness, thickness and the toughness of the petals and determines the degree of durability of form and keeping quality of the bloom

**Stem and Foliage:** **20 points**  
Stem to be primary. Foliage should be clean and not damaged by spray or wind

**Size:** **10 points**  
Should be typical, neither overgrown or under size

**Balance and Proportion:** **10 points**  
Overall appearance - bloom, stem and foliage should be harmonious

**Total: 100 points**

Container provided by exhibitor.

**CLASS 81 MINI-FLORA  
ROSE BOWL**

One mini-flora bloom, any variety.  
One set of detached leaves permitted.  
Container provided by exhibitor.

**CLASS 82 THREE MINIATURE OR  
MINI-FLORA BLOOMS**

Any combination of miniature or mini-flora varieties.  
One bloom per stem, in exhibition form.  
Exhibited in one container.

**CLASS 83 MINIATURE  
CYCLE OF BLOOM**

Any miniature or mini-flora rose. All the same  
variety; one bud with sepals down, petals just  
beginning to unfurl; one bloom in show from; and one  
bloom withstamens showing.  
Exhibited in three containers.

**CLASS 84 MINIATURE  
ROSE BOUQUET**

Any combination of miniature and/or mini-flora  
varieties,  
using at least twelve (12) stems with blooms.  
Bouquet using roses and rose foliage  
only. Container provided  
by exhibitor.

**CLASS 85 TRAILING ROSE**

One truss, trailing rose, any variety. Exhibited  
in an orchid tube, on a dinner napkin size  
piece of cloth, lying on the table.  
Cloth and orchid tube provided  
by exhibitor.

**CLASS 86            ROSE BOWL**

One bloom. Any variety except miniature or mini-flora. One set of detached leaves permitted.  
Container provided by exhibitor.

**CLASS 87            ROSE BOUQUET**

Any combination of varieties, except miniature or mini-floras. Using at least twelve (12) stems with bloom or blooms. Bouquet using roses and rose foliage only. Container provided by exhibitor.

**CLASS 88        "TIN CAN DERBY"**

A bouquet of your leftover blooms. Exhibited in a tin can. Container provided by exhibitor.  
Limited to exhibitors who have placed a minimum of 10 entries in this show.  
Varieties NOT to be named.

**SECTION D  
DISTRICT SECTION**

Open only to American Rose Society or Local Rose Society members residing in the NCNH District.  
Each container in all classes must have its own entry tag.

Three (3) light, medium, deep yellow, or yellow-blend hybrid teas. One variety or three different varieties exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 103  
          CAPTAIN HARRY STEBBINGS TROPHY**

Three (3) light, medium or deep pink hybrid teas, disbudded, any combination of varieties, exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 104  
          CLYDE H. STOCKING  
          MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Three (3) pink-blend hybrid teas.  
One variety or three different varieties exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 105  
          ALFRED LELOY JR.  
          MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Three (3) medium red or dark red hybrid teas. One variety or three different varieties exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 106  
          DR. RON BROOKS  
          PERPETUAL TROPHY**

Three (3) different disbudded varieties of hybrid teas introduced within the last five years (2004-2008),  
Exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 107  
          ESTHER K. HUGHES "PEACE" TROPHY**

One (1) disbudded specimen if any hybrid tea containing "Peace" in its name.

**CLASS 108  
          AMERICAN ROSE FOUNDATION  
          WINDSOUNDS TROPHY**

Hybrid tea cycle of bloom. Three (3) hybrid teas of the same variety, a bud with color, an exhibition stage bloom, and a fully open bloom, exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 109  
          BAPTISTE MICHELIS  
          MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Three (3) stems consisting of one hybrid tea (disbudded), one grandiflora (disbudded)  
And one floribunda spray,  
Exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 110****RICHARD TYSON  
MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Five (5) stems consisting of three hybrid teas (disbudded), and two floribunda sprays, exhibited in separate containers. Any combination of varieties.

**CLASS 111****LAURA SUTTER  
MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Three (3) mauve or mauve-blend roses. Three different varieties of any types exhibited  
In separate containers.

**CLASS 112****RAMONA STOCKING TROPHY**

One (1) floribunda spray, any variety.

**CLASS 113****J. HARVEY BROWN  
PERPETUAL TROPHY**

Three (3) floribunda sprays, one variety or three different varieties, exhibited in separate containers.

**CLASS 114****ALL-AMERICA ROSE SELECTION  
CHALLENGE CLASS**

Three (3) different AARS winners, any types, exhibited in separate containers. All one bloom per stem entries except shrubs must be shown disbudded.

One (1) stem of any type of single rose up To eight (8) petals. One bloom per stem or one spray.

**CLASS 116****CLEMENTINA MONTELEONE  
PERPETUAL TROPHY**

One (1) disbudded specimen, of any class, dark or medium red, fragrant rose with exhibition form.

**CLASS 117****CLAY MORGAN  
DISTRICT TROPHY**

English-style box of six (6) hybrid teas or Grandiflora roses, no more than two of any variety. Box supplied by the exhibitor.

**CLASS 118****DR. HOWARD I. GALLAGHER  
MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Miniature English-style Box of six (6) different miniature varieties.  
Box supplied by exhibitor.

**CLASS 119****RALPH S. MOORE TROPHY**

Seven (7) miniature roses each a different variety, exhibited in separate containers. If there are fewer than three (3) entries, the class shall not be judged unless, in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is outstanding and merits the honor.
