ARRANGEMENT DIVISION GENERAL RULES

1. The arrangement entries in the Northern California-Nevada-Hawaii District Rose Show will be judged by the standards published in *Guidelines for Judging Rose Arrangements*.
2. All exhibitors must be registered for the conference and reside in the NCNH District of the ARS (judges may be from other Districts of ARS or the National Garden Club).
3. In order to assure adequate space, exhibitors of arrangements must register in advance. E-mail or phone Martin Kooi (mkooi1@hotmail.com) Cell: 415-254-4856
*Deadline for reserving your space is **September 20, 2019**.*
4. Arrangement entry tags should be used for all entries.
5. Roses used must be grown outdoors in the exhibitor's garden. Other flowers, foliage, and accessories need not be the product of the exhibitor and are permitted in all classes except where specified. No artificial flowers, foliage, nor treated or painted fresh plant material is permitted.
6. Roses must be the dominant flowers. To receive ARS medal awards, roses must be arranger grown with 'AG' written on the entry tag, and must be correctly named. A Novice in Arrangements has not won more than one blue ribbon in any District Arrangements Show.
7. Exhibitors are permitted only one entry per class but may enter any and all classes in which they are eligible.
8. Entries will be received from 6:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. on Sat, September 28th. Judging will begin at 10:30 a.m. sharp.
9. Neither the NCNH District nor the Gold Country Rose Society nor the Holiday Inn shall be held responsible for loss or damage of properties.
Please pick up arrangements on Saturday between 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.
10. NCNH Judges who are judging arrangements in this show may enter their arrangements only in Judges Arrangements, Section G.
11. The decisions of the judges are final.

CLASS 5 “Claim Jumper” – Modern Line Mass, design must indicate motion

SECTION C Oriental Manner Arrangements

CLASS 6 “China Camp” – freestyle design using a tall or medium container.

CLASS 7 “American River” – use a low container, water must show

SECTION D Miniflora Arrangement – Not to exceed 12” in height, width, or depth.

CLASS 8 “Nature’s Nuggets” - Traditional Line Mass

CLASS 9 “Pan for Gold” - Oriental Manner

CLASS 10 “Eureka!” – modern abstract design

SECTION E Miniature Arrangements. Not to exceed 10 inches in height, width or depth.

CLASS 11 “Chop Sticks” -Traditional Line Mass

CLASS 12 “Mother Lode” - Oriental Manner

CLASS 13 “Fool’s Gold” - Transparency

SECTION F Novice Arrangements

CLASS 14 “Forty Niner” – Designers choice of style – Standard size design

CLASS 15 “Sierra Treasures” – Designers choice of style – Miniature design 10” or less
Type of design must be written on entry tag.
